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### **APPOINTMENTS**

We have a book on the day system for appointments that are needed the same day. Patients ring the surgery at 8.00 am for a morning appointment and 11.00 am for an afternoon appointment.

**Non- urgent/routine appointments** can be made up to 4 to 6 weeks in advance either at the surgery or by telephone between 8am and 6pm Monday to Friday. Alternatively appointments can be booked online. Any home visits needed for that day should be phoned through by 11.00am at the latest.

# What the Northolme Practice has to offer.

**Doctors**. We have 6 GP Partners, 1 Salaried GP, 3 Registrars and 1 FY2 who work closely with Dr Chin, Dr Ross and Dr Howes.

Dr Ross and Dr Santhanam provide Minor Surgery. Dr Cameron and Dr Howes provide coil and implant fitting and removal.

Advanced Nurse Practitioner (ANP) Julie Gledhill, Julie Raine, Sarah Jowitt and Jenny Chambers. They work alongside the Doctors, they can refer and prescribe. Practice Nurse- We currently have 3 practice nurses, Jane, Lauren & Savoula (Lead Nurse).

Practice nurses are qualified and registered nurses. They can help with health issues such as travel advice/immunisations, carry out cervical smears, offer advice about contraception, healthy living advice, routine vaccinations & dressings. The practice nurses also manage long-term health conditions such as asthma, COPD and diabetes.

Healthcare assistant- Helen supports the practice nurses with their daily work and carry out tasks such as injections (B12/flu/shingles/pneumococcal) for adults, spirometry (lung function tests), dressings, blood pressure measurement, including 24 hour blood pressure monitors, suture removal, smoking cessation advice, NHS health checks & new patient checks.

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### EAR SYRINGING

We offer a limited ear syringing service for adults after being assessed by a clinician.

In general, we understand that irrigation should rarely be necessary. The most effective way to manage ear canal blockage due to wax or debris is the application of ear drops and/or olive oil, which should disperse excessive wax and regular application will prevent the build-up of wax. Brand names you may have heard of include Earex, Cerumol and Otex (there are others).

### **GP Online Services update...**

**Online access to your medical record** - the surgery has recently enabled additional functionality to the online services we offer. Patients can now request access to their detailed medical record via the online service website or online service app.

Access for parents/guardians and carers, (known as proxy access) - the surgery will be introducing proxy access early this year. This will make it much more convenient for parents and carers to make appointments or request medication online on behalf of their children, or someone they care for.
